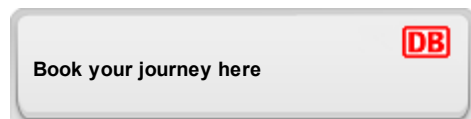

<sup>1</sup> You can buy your ticket by phone: just contact our service number +49 (0)1806 - 31 11 53 and use the keyword "Messe Berlin". Make sure you have your credit card to hand for payment (please note that Deutsche Bahn AG levies a surcharge for all credit card payments in accordance with the conditions of carriage for persons travelling with Deutsche Bahn AG companies ("BB Personenverkehr"). The service hotline is open Mondays to Saturdays from 7am to 10pm. There is a charge of EUR 0.20 per call from a German landline and a maximum of EUR 0.60 per call from mobile networks.


## Arriving by Public Transportation / Taxi

Direct access to the grounds from one of the world's best public transport systems means that getting here is always quick and easy. There are taxi ranks, underground/light rail stations and bus stops next to our entrances. Berlin's public transport system will take you swiftly and in comfort to the destination of your choice.
